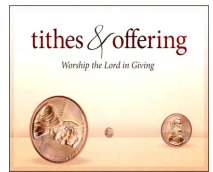

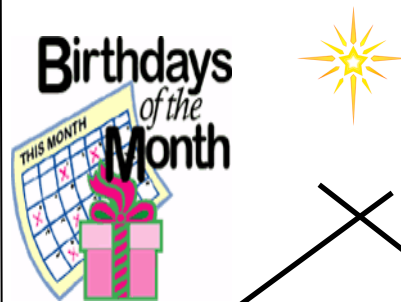


We will be collecting mac and cheese, juice, can tuna or chicken, hot or cold cereal, spaghetti sauce and can vegetable. Thank you for your generosity!
