
BAPTISM PREPARATION

Black History Month



Actor, film director and diplomat Sidney Poitier was born on February 20, 1927. He was the first Bahamian Black American actor to win the Academy Award for best actor in 1963, the first of many. He paved the way for Black actors in film. He received the President Medal of Freedom from President Barack Obama (first Black President of USA) in 2009 and made Honorary Knight Commander of the Order of the British Empire by Queen Elizabeth II in 1974. He died in January 6, 2022.
