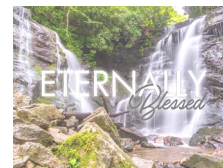

Steps to a good confession.

Prayer

Examination of Conscience

Contrition – Contrition involves a realization of and deep sorrow for the hurt I have caused by my sins and failures and a resolution to try to avoid these acts in the future.

Rite of Reconciliation (Confession)

Greeting between the priest and the penitent.

The traditional way to begin is to say: "Bless me Father for I have sinned. This is my first confession. (or the length of time since your last confession)".

Confession of your sins. Try to tell your sins in terms of your life rather than just a list. You can do this in five simple steps.

Who am I.

What I did.

Why I think I did it.

The results or effects of my actions or failures.

How I think I could do better.

Listen to the priest's words of advice.

Acceptance of Penance

Act of Contrition (said before you leave) – O my God I am sorry for my sins. In choosing to sin and in failing to do good I have sinned against you and your church. I firmly intend with the help of your Son to make up for my sins and to love as I should.

Absolution by the priest

Dismissal by the priest

Performance of penance (done after you leave the priest.)
