Women's History Month

Mother Teresa was born Skopje and migrated to India in 1929 where she remained for most of her life. From an early age, she knew that she should be a religious. She spent the rest of her ministry with the poor, living among them and caring for them.

She opened many hospice, orphanages and leper houses in Calcutta and around the world. Mother Teresa died on September 5, 1997 at the age of 87. She was canonized a saint in 2016 by Pope Francis. Her feast day is September 5.
