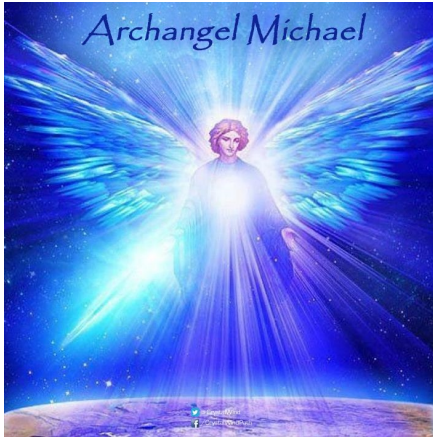

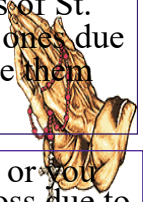
**Our Mass Schedule is as follows:**
