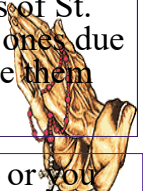

Please pray for the members of St. Pius X who have lost loved ones due to Covid-19. May God give them the strength to heal.

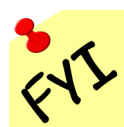

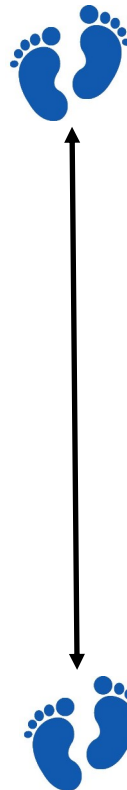

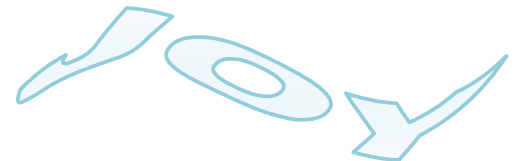


Don't forget to wear a mask when you go to the rectory. Or anywhere else. Your life matters.
