*The use of ashes in the Liturgy beginning the penitential season of Lent is credited to Pope Saint Gregory the Great who during his papacy(590-604) introduced its use to the Liturgy of Rome. Ashes were first sprinkled collectively over the congregation and then later individually on the crown of the head of each of the faithful with the Old Testament injunction from Genesis: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return." This practice spread throughout the Universal Church and was further codified with the reforms of the Council of Trent(1545-1563).*

**The 2021 Mass Book** is now open and Mass Offering is \$15. According to Canon Law, we have to offer a Mass Intention at least one time a year. Examples are birthday blessings, good health, in honor of a saint, deceased person, etc.

*Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the church will be sprinkling ashes on the heads of the parishioners on Ash Wednesday.*

Lent is a liturgical season beginning on Ash Wednesday and ending on Holy Saturday. It is a time of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. We abstain from meat on Fridays during Lent. We fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. The Ashes represent our need for forgiveness. They also remind us that we are made from dust and to dust we will return.

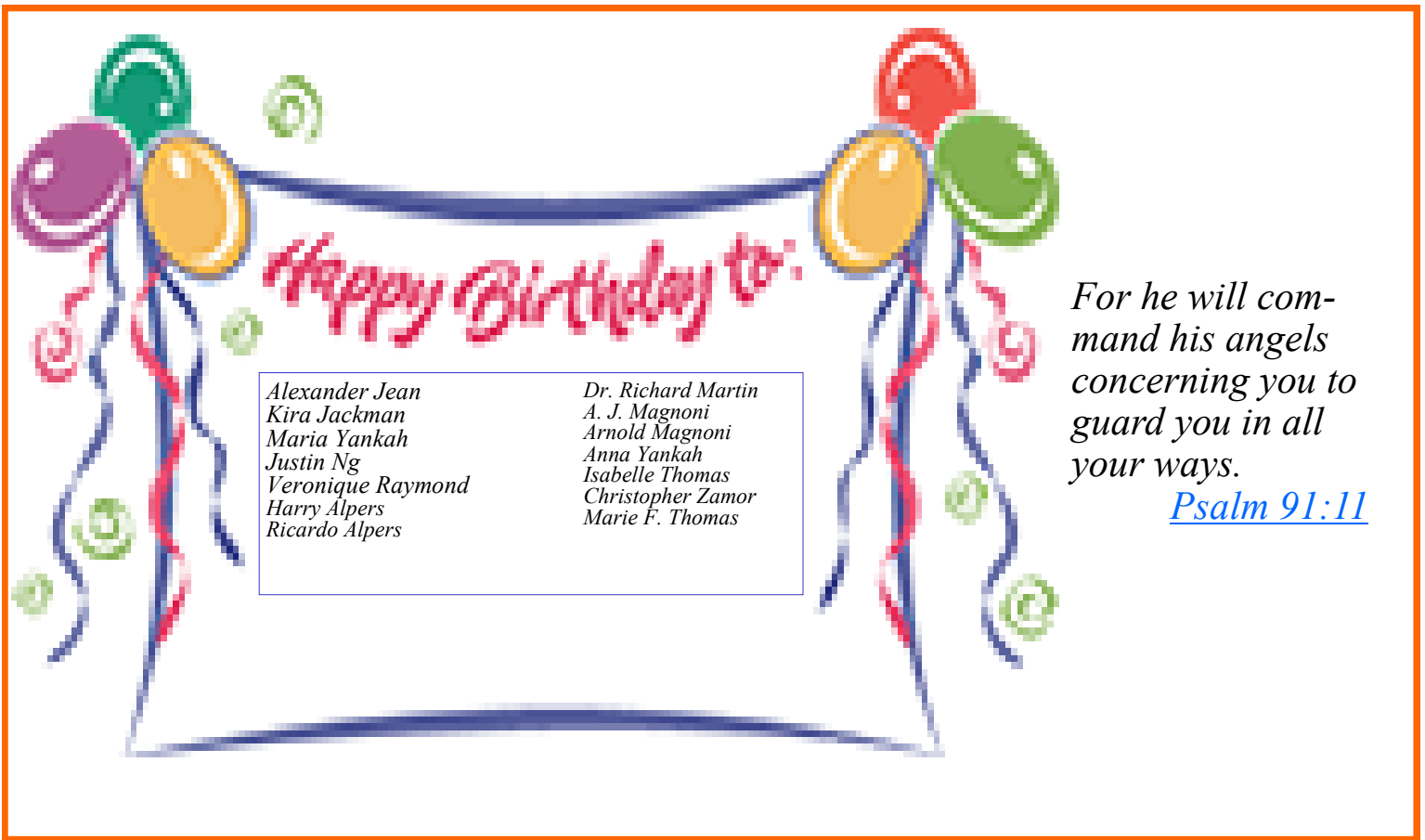
