The obligation to attend Holy Mass on Sunday is a sacred one and must be taken seriously. The dispensation from this obligation which has been in effect since the start of the pandemic will be lifted as of the weekend of June 5-6, the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of the Lord (Corpus Christi). Although the dispensation will be lifted, those who are ill, or feeling unwell, those who care for the sick and those truly at risk are automatically dispensed from the obligation, as is always the case.

As the Bishops of New York State has stated: “The term ‘obligation’ does not adequately express the great privilege that is ours regarding attendance at Mass. It is not a ‘chore’ as the word could sound to modern ears. The Mass is the greatest gift that Our Lord has given to His people. It is a supernatural moment in which we are truly in His presence, to relive His passion, death and resurrection, to hear His holy Word, receive Him in Holy Communion, and give Him thanks and praise for blessings. More than an obligation, it is a remarkable opportunity – one not to be missed.”
